In the same meeting it was further decided regarding the validity of the nomination form that :

- Any document that proves age will be accepted as valid.
- Any designated officer or self-attested individual can verify the age proof documents.
- Record of attendance will be on the basis of the date of available attendance record of the concerned department for the contesting candidate.
- The Controller of Examinations will certify the concerned candidate if he / she has any arrears in the University Examination.
- The certificate of no criminal conviction for the contesting candidate will be issued from the office of DSW, Bhattadev University.

At a subsequent joint meeting of the Bhattadev University Election Commission, Observers, and Grievance Redressal Cell held on October 28, 2024, at 2:30 PM in the Conference Hall of the Administration Block of Bhattadev University, the following important decisions were taken:

- Total number of voting (polling) booth will be 9 (nine).
- Total number of counting hall will be 3 (three).
- The ballot paper will include photos of the finally contesting candidates.
- The maximum number of employees of Bhattadev University will take part in the polling and counting process.
- Mobile phones are not permitted for candidates and counting agents in the counting hall.
- Visitors will not be allowed on campus during the counting period unless they have permission from the administration.
- Each candidate will get 5 minutes for their speech during the open debate.
- Candidates will receive the appointment of polling & counting agent form on November 4, 2024, at the central library, Bhattadev University.
- After the end of the poll, the university campus will be evacuated. Only employees, contesting candidates and counting agents will be permitted to remain inside.


