

NSS Cell, Bhattadev University, Bajali

Activities organized since August to mid-December, 2024

1. Amrit Brikhya Andolan, 1st – 15th, August, 2024

It was an initiative of the Forest Department, GoA aimed to plant 3 crore commercially valuable trees across Assam. The volunteers of NSS Cell, Bhattadev University has planted such 500 saplings in the BU campus and across different places of Bajali district.



2. Certificate distribution ceremony under Nizut Moina Scheme, 5th August, 2024

It is a program to provide financial assistance to female students of the state to encourage them to continue their higher education. The Bajali district administration has distributed certificates to the beneficiaries at Bhattadev University on 5th August, 2024. The volunteers of NSS Cell, BU help the district administration in distribution and proper management of the program in the BU campus. 30 volunteers were participated in this program.



3. Nisha Mukta Bharat Abhiyan, 12th August, 2024

It mainly aimed at building nation with healthy and disciplined youth. It intends to reach out the masses and spread awareness about substances abuse through various activities. 113 NSS volunteers of NSS Cell, BU along with the students of Bhattadev University took pledge against use of addicted substances in their lives.



4. Celebration of Independence Day, 15th August, 2024

India got its independence on 15th August, 1947. Therefore, this auspicious day is celebrated as independence day of India. 63 NSS volunteers were participated in this event organized the by the Bhattadev University, Bajali.



5. Celebration of Foundation Day, 16th August, 2024

The erstwhile Bajali College was established on 16th August, 1955; which was later upgraded to Bhattadev University. The day was celebrated as the Foundation Day of the university. APSC Chairmen, Shri Bharat Bhushan Dev Choudhury was the invited guest for the Kameswar Das Memorial Foundation Day Lecture. 164 NSS volunteers were participated in the program and they also took part in the **Anti-Ragging Rally** organized by the university on 16th August, 2024.



6. Street Play against sexual assault on 31st August, 2024

Sexual assault is one of the major offences that took place in a society. It is being observed that such crimes against women are rising nowadays. Awareness among the people is much needed to stop such heinous act. The NSS Cell of Bhattadev University has performed a street play against such crimes at two places of Pathsala namely, at Pathsala Bus-stand near the Bhargabi Restaurant and in-front of the Bhattadev University Gate on 31st August, 2024 which was themed on “*Sorai aru Danobor hadhu*”. The play also in solidarity with the heinous crime that took place in R. G. Kar Medical College and Hospital of Kolkata on 9th August, 2024.



7. Plantation Drive, 18th September, 2024

Plantation of trees is very significant to save our mother earth. Trees were planted in the Bhattadev University Campus by NSS volunteers along with the Campus Beautification Committee of the university on 19th September. Several saplings of white and pink *kanchan* flower has planted in-front of the departments of Science faculties.



8. Swachhata Hi Seva Campaign, 17th September- 2nd October, 2024

It is a two week-long community mobilization drive to clean-up India and make it garbage free. The campaign was organized annually by the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs and Ministry of Jal Shakti. With regard to this, NSS Cell, BU has conducted a cleanliness drive at BU campus and Pathalsala Railway Station and collected about 63 kgs of garbage from the mentioned places.



9. Celebration of NSS Day, 24th September, 2024

NSS was formally launched on 24th September, 1969. Therefore, 24 September is celebrated every year as NSS Day with appropriate programs and activities. The NSS Cell of Bhattadev University has conducted a range of programs to celebrate this auspicious day. The day was started with a **Cleanliness Drive** at the BU campus collecting polythenes and plastics. It was followed by a **plantation program** at the campus. A **street play** on sexual abuse was also an eye-catching event of the NSS Day celebration, which was mainly organized to spread the

message among the student community of the university. **Orientation cum NSS Day Celebration lecture** was given by the special invitee Dr. Ranjan Kr. Kakati, DSW, Gauhati University and Program Coordinator, NSS, GU. He has enlighten the NSS volunteers by focusing various aspects of NSS- its significance, motto, various activities, awards for NSS volunteers etc.



10. University Freshmen-Social, 1st October, 2024
