

Policy for Admission under Extra-Curricular Activities (ECA) Quota Bhattadev University, Bajali

(Admission under ECA Quota shall be subject to applicable Government reservation policies and University regulations.)

Bhattadev University recognizes the importance of holistic education and the role of extra-curricular activities in the overall development of students. The University encourages excellence in sports, culture, leadership, social service, national integration, and community engagement.

To promote and support talented students who have demonstrated outstanding achievements in extra-curricular fields, the University hereby adopts this policy for admission under the Extra-Curricular Activities (ECA) Quota. The policy shall come into force from the date of approval by the competent authority of the University

The objectives of the policy are:

1. To encourage participation in sports, cultural, literary, social, and national service activities.
2. To recognize and reward outstanding achievements beyond academics.
3. To promote balanced personality development among students.
4. To strengthen the University's representation in inter-university, state, national, and international events.
5. To provide opportunities to deserving students possessing exceptional talents.

Nature of ECA Quota:

1. Admission under the ECA Quota shall be made against a limited number of seats within the approved intakes decided by the University from time to time as well as mapped in the SAMARTH Portal
2. The total number of seats under ECA Quota shall ordinarily not exceed **2% of the sanctioned intake** of a programme.

Categories Covered under ECA Quota:

The following categories shall be considered under the ECA Quota:

1. All Sports, Cultural Events and Literary Events recognized by Association of Indian Universities (AIU)
2. NCC 'A', 'B', or 'C' Certificate holders, Participation in Youth Exchange Program, Republic Day Camp, National Integration Camp and State or National level NCC achievements. However 'C' certificate will get highest weightage under this category.
3. NSS Volunteers 'A', 'B' or 'C', Participation in Republic Day Camp, National Integration Camp and Outstanding community service activities recognized by Govt. However 'C' certificate will get highest weightage under this category.



Eligibility Criteria

A candidate seeking admission under ECA Quota must:

1. Fulfill the minimum academic eligibility criteria prescribed for the programme by the University.
2. Submit valid certificates/documents supporting the claim under ECA category.
3. Have participated in recognized competitions/events at district, state, national, or international level.
4. Appear in trial/audition/interaction organized by University, wherever applicable.
5. Produce original documents during verification.

Priority of Achievement

Preference shall ordinarily be given in the following order:

1. International Level
2. National Level
3. Inter-University Level
4. State Level
5. District Level

Higher achievements within the same category shall receive higher consideration.

Validity of Certificates

1. Certificates issued by recognized authorities/organizations only shall be accepted.
2. Certificates obtained within the **last three years preceding** the admission year shall ordinarily be considered.
3. The University reserves the right to verify the authenticity of any certificate.

ECA Admission Committee

The University shall constitute an **ECA Admission Committee** consisting of:

1. Academic Registrar - Chairperson
2. Dean, Students' Welfare – Member
3. Associate Dean, Students' Welfare(I) – Member
4. Associate Dean, Students' Welfare(II) – Member
5. One faculty member from concerned department – Member
6. Admission In-charge – Member Secretary

Selection Procedure

1. Applications under ECA Quota shall be invited along with regular admissions.
2. Candidates shall apply in prescribed format.
3. Selection may be based on:
 - a) Academic eligibility,
 - b) Achievement certificates,
 - c) Trials/auditions/interactions (Wherever necessary)
 - d) Performance assessment.



Cancellation of Admission

Admission under ECA Quota may be cancelled if:

1. False or fabricated documents are submitted.
2. Eligibility conditions are not fulfilled.
3. Misconduct or indiscipline is established.

The decision of the University shall be final.

Any matter relating to interpretation of this policy shall be referred to the Vice Chancellor, whose decision shall be final. The University reserves the right to amend, modify, or repeal any provision of this policy with approval of the competent authority.
