**Two-Days Awareness cum Extension Programme in Bhattadev University
to observe International Women's Day**

Pathsala, March 8: The Women Cell, Bhattadev University had organized a “Two-days Awareness cum Extension Programme” on 7th and 8th March, 2025 on the occasion of International Women's Day. On 7th March, a gender sensitization and awareness programme was organized within the university campus. Prof. Dhanapati Deka, Hon'ble Vice Chancellor of Bhattadev University inaugurated the leaflet distribution event which emphasized on various women issues and mechanisms of women help inside and outside the campus. Dr. Dulumani Deka, President, Women Cell cum Associate Professor, Department of Assamese delivered a speech on the significance of celebration of Women's Day. The Secretary of the Women Cell cum Assistant Professor, Department of Sociology, Dr. Nabanita Baruah addressed the objectives of the two-days awareness cum extension programme by highlighting the theme “Accelerating Action”.

On 8th March, an extension activity focusing on a Free Health Check-up Camp was organized in the Bhotanta Mohitara Village, Saderi, Bajali. The event began with a plantation programme in the Padmastri Chandraprabha High School with the cooperation of the Headmaster Mr. Ganesh Roy. It followed a Free Health Check-up from Nityananda BPHE team where doctors and paramedical staffs undertook free medical health check-up for the women of the village with the support of the Village Head, Mrs. Parul Medhi. Free medicines on blood pressure, calcium deficiency, eye drops, gastric problems etc. were provided as prescribed by the doctors to the women. Dr. Urmi Devi Choudhury, consultant Gynecologist from Nalbari district was also present in the camp. Ms. Kasmita Bora, a member of Women Cell cum Assistant Professor, Department of Political Science offered the vote of thanks to the entire medical staffs, other officials and all the participants.
