# UNIVERSITY PROFILE

Bhattadev University, Bajali, is the realization of a long-cherished dream of the people of the greater Bajali region, Assam, which came into being on the 24th of June, 2019, after the first Vice-Chancellor of the University, Prof. Birinchi Kr. Das, assumed office. The University was upgraded from the erstwhile Bajali College, which had a glorious history of more than six decades and was widely recognized as one of the prominent educational institutions in the state of Assam. The University was established by an Act of the State Legislature - Bhattadev University Act, 2017, to which the Governor of Assam gave his assent on the 16th of October, 2017. It is named after an illustrious son of Assam, Baikunthanath Bhagavat Bhattacharya, popularly known as Bhattadev, who is acknowledged as the father of Assamese prose.

Bhattadev's erudition in Sanskrit grammar and literature, along with his command over the Shrimadbhagavata Purana, earned him the title of Bhagavat Bhattacharya.

Bajali College was the fruition of the vision and dedication of many prominent individuals of Bajali, as well as the toil and sacrifice of the local agrarian community, who contributed from their earnings of selling rice paddy to the establishment of the college. Bajali College was established under the dynamic leadership of Kameswar Das, a Gold Medalist from Calcutta University.



Starting from its humble origins in the year 1955, Bajali College strived towards academic excellence and came to be known as one of the best colleges for science education in Assam. It is worth mentioning here that Bajali College had started postgraduate programmes in Geography and Zoology way back in the early 1980s, with the M.Sc programme in the Department of Geography being the second oldest one in Assam after that of Gauhati University. The College was Bajali accredited with “A” Grade in its 2nd cycle by NAAC in the year 2016.

Following its establishment as a University in 2019, Bhattadev University introduced the postgraduate program in Physics in the very first year of its inception. The University commenced a 5-year Integrated M.Sc. Program in Chemistry from the 2022-23 academic session onward. Currently, Bhattadev University is running 10 Master’s programmes in Mathematics, Assamese, Zoology, Geography, Chemistry, Commerce, Economics, English, Physics and Political Science. The University has also begun Ph.D. programmes in several subject areas, effective from 2021.

The Government of Assam has allocated a larger plot of land to build a second campus for the University at a nearby place called Medhikuchi, where, with generous funding from the Government of Assam, new construction works have already begun. In addition, the institution is developing and refurbishing its infrastructure at its existing campus in Pathsala town and has implemented NEP 2020 from the academic year 2023-2024. Sixteen bright individuals have recently been appointed as Assistant Professors in various departments of the University, and in addition to filling up three more vacancies of Assistant Professor posts, the University is also preparing to recruit seven Professors, 14 Associate Professors, and 14 Assistant Professors against new posts sanctioned by the Government in the recent past. The University is also taking steps to recruit non-teaching staff members against sanctioned posts.

The emblem has been designed by modifying the emblem of erstwhile Bajali College following the addition of a Puranic motto ‘sā vidyā yā vimuktaye’ with the meaning ‘Knowledge is that which liberates’. Let knowledge liberate us from disease, grief, greed, envy, sin, poverty, bondage, dearth, ignorance, superstition, narrowness etc. Let there be an institution of excellence at Bajali, a university that will attract the best of minds – students, staff and visitors alike and let the university help us in understanding the society we live in and at the same time, in providing solutions to the problems that the society faces.

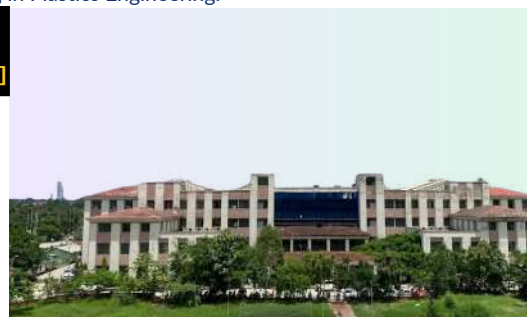

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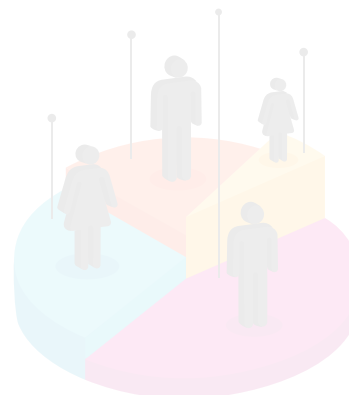

## Admission Process for FYUGP & FYIMP

Bhattadev University invites applications for its Four-Year Undergraduate Programs (FYUGP – B.A., B.Sc.) and Five-Year Integrated Master Programs (FYIMP) for the academic session 2025–26. All applications must be submitted through the official **SAMARTH online admission portal** of the Department of Higher Education, Government of Assam: <https://assamadmission.samarth.ac.in>.

Applicants are strongly encouraged to generate their **Unique ID** from the Higher Education Department and complete the registration, profile filling, and program selection processes well before the deadlines. All activities, including merit list generation and admission, are governed by timelines released by the Directorate of Higher Education, Assam.

Along with the University admission for the new academic year, female students' can apply for admission to the hostel as per rules mentioned in the Hostel prospectus.

# INSTITUTIONAL BIOTECH HUB

Institutional Biotech Hub at Bhattadev University, Bajali was established in the year of 2014 under the aegis of Department of Biotechnology, Govt of India. Incorporation of such an advanced laboratory at University level (formerly Bajali College) is to inculcate interest for Biotechnology among the budding scientist at UG, PG and PhD level. Also, it will impart training in sophisticated technology by providing necessary infrastructural facility. Apart from its own research activities the hub has engaged in many, Biological Science related activities. Starting from its inception every year workshops, seminars, awareness & training programs are being conducted at our own institution and nearby schools and college level.

## Financial assistance received from DBT

- 1 Initial Funding Boost (2013–14):** Received ₹26.50 lakhs in the first year, marking the major initial investment phase.
- 2 Subsequent Allocations:** Funding tapered to ₹4.02 lakhs in 2014–15 and ₹3.44 lakhs in 2015–16, indicating a decline in annual support.
- 3 Total Support Over 3 Years:** Cumulatively, ₹33.96 lakhs were received over the first three financial years.

After successfully completion of First Phase, the Ministry of Science and Technology Department of Biotechnology, Government of India has sanctioned **Rs. 31,55,200/-** (Rupees Thirty-one Lakh Fifty-Five Thousand Two Hundred only) on 09th March 2023 for the implementation of the project entitled “DBT–NER Institutional Biotech Hubs at Bhattadev University, Bajali, Assam (Phase II)” for a period of 3 years.

# NATIONAL CADET CORPS (NCC)

The NCC unit of Bhattadev University comprises two companies under the NER NCC Directorate: the 7 Assam Battalion NCC, Dhubri (est. 1965) and the 60 Assam Girls' Battalion NCC, Guwahati (est. 1963). Both units operate under the Guwahati HQ and are known for excellence in training, community service, and national-level participation.

The 7 Assam Battalion, affiliated initially with Barpeta and later Dhubri, was led by Late Harendra Nath Deka, the first ANO. The Girls' Battalion, though inactive for some time, was revived in 2002 by Dr. Polly Vauqueline and has since been actively contributing to student development.

These units embody NCC's values of discipline, leadership, and patriotism, currently with 73 cadets in the 7 Assam Battalion and 54 cadets in the Girls' Battalion.
